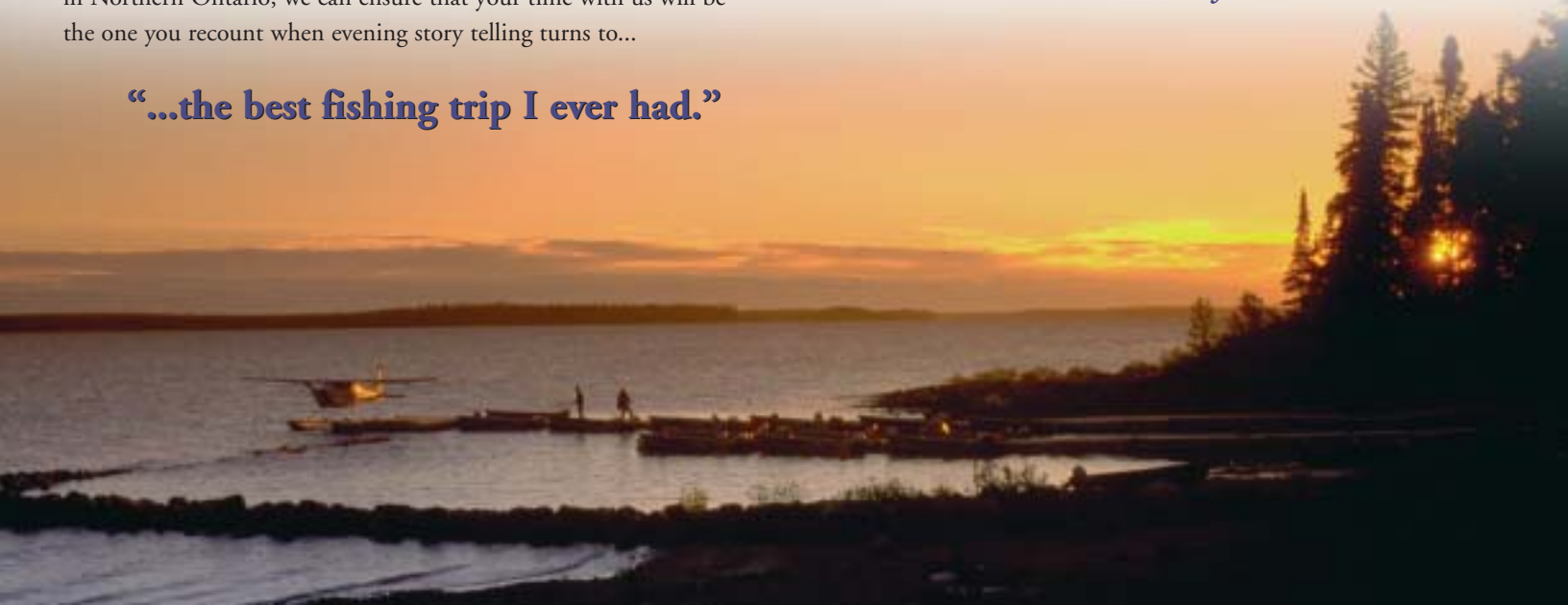

Liddle's Fishing Adventures operates the only two luxury American Plan fly-in fishing lodges on the Albany River system, Miminiska Lodge and Makokibatan Lodge, as well as an ultra-modern outpost camp.

Direct paved highways lead to our departure points of Thunder Bay and Nakina. From there you will enjoy a spectacular flight over the vast wilderness towards the Albany River. Guests heading to Miminiska Lodge can depart from Thunder Bay International Airport or from the airport in Nakina, with direct flights to the lodge's own airstrip. Thunder Bay airport is well serviced by several airlines that connect with most cities in the U.S. and Canada.

Makokibatan Lodge and Makok Outpost guests depart from the floatplane base in Nakina. For those wishing to drive to Nakina, this

community can be reached from the east through Sault Ste. Marie or from the west through Thunder Bay. Guests wishing to fly to Thunder Bay may consider taking a rental car for 3 1/2 hour drive to Nakina.
